**Face the Facts** is a presentation that explores the world of facebook and discusses it's impact on society today. Whenever possible, the presentation includes an on-line demonstration about the social networking site to help participants learn to navigate and discover privacy settings.

### **Face the Facts for students**

*Assembly style:* One hour presentation in the library or gymnasium for one grade at a time whenever possible. An on-line component is include if a internet connection is available at the school

*Classroom presentation:* One hour presentation to students in their classroom which allows for more questions and further exploration of strategies.

*Additional presentation options:* A full day of presentations, one grade at a time, based on the school schedule. The best possible location for this type of day is in the library or gymnasium with students coming to the presentation at their scheduled time and sit on chairs.

### **Face the Facts for parents**

A two hour presentation designed to help parents learn new skills and navigate facebook in order to promote safety on-line. You will have the opportunity to discuss today's new approach to socializing, communicating and dating.

### **Face the Facts for school staff**

*Lunch and Learn:* Brief presentation about the concept during a scheduled lunch at your school. This option also lends itself to a one hour session immediately following the school day.

Teachers, custodians, CYW's and office staff are all encouraged to participate in the session. You will learn to implement strategies and discuss their implementation as a team.

*P.A Day or PLC time:* We will deliver a presentation created specifically designed to fit the needs of the school staff and the climate of the school environment.
