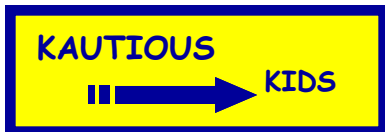

The focus of this half day workshop is to prepare children to be safe when they are home alone. Important skills are stressed through interactive lessons and role-play to help make both the child and their parents more confident during those times. We address the child's rights and responsibilities when at home alone, how to respond safely to phone calls and unexpected visitors, how to keep constructively occupied and basic self-defense techniques are taught.



This a two hour workshop children grades 4 to 6 and their parents. Participants learn about street safety, community safety, sensible safety strategies and hands-on tactics to escape unwanted grabs or attacks. Students and parents working together has proven to be an effective way to learn about safety and encourage commitment to staying safe.

Bullyology

Bullyology is a unique approach to identifying and preventing bullying.
